

Annual Employment-Unemployment Survey

I. In order to fill the data gap for ascertaining the employment-unemployment scenario in the country, Labour Bureau has been entrusted by the Ministry the task of conducting Annual Employment-Unemployment surveys. So far two such surveys have been conducted by Labour Bureau and thereon reports released. The field work of **fifth Annual Employment-Unemployment Survey** is in progress.

II. First Annual Employment & Unemployment survey

Labour Bureau launched its first Nation-wide Employment and Unemployment survey in April, 2010 to assess the employment scenario in the country. The survey was conducted in 300 districts spread across 28 States/UT. About 46,000 household schedules were surveyed during the survey. A multi stage stratified systematic sampling technique was adopted for the survey. The report was released by the Ministry in November, 2010.

III. Second Annual Employment-Unemployment Survey

The Second Employment-Unemployment Survey (EUS) was launched in July, 2011. In the second EUS survey all the districts in the 35 States/UTs of the country were covered. The sample size in the second EUS was 1.28 lakh household schedules. A multi stage stratified systematic sampling technique was adopted for the survey. The report was released in the month of July, 2012.

IV. Third Annual Employment-Unemployment Survey

The Third Employment-Unemployment Survey (EUS) was launched in October, 2012. The field work has been completed. In the third survey all the districts in the 35 States/UTs of the country are covered. The sample size in the third EUS is about 1.35 lakh household schedules. The report was released in the month of September, 2013.

V. FOURTH ANNUAL EMPLOYMENT-UNEMPLOYMENT SURVEY

The fourth Annual Employment-Unemployment Survey was launched in the month of December, 2013. In the fourth Annual Employment-Unemployment Survey, all the districts in the 36 States/UTs of the country are covered. The sample size in the fourth EUS is about 1.36 lakh household schedules. The report has been released in the month of January, 2015.

Labour Force Participation Rate (LFPR), Worker Population Ratio (WPR) and Unemployment Rate (UR) based on UPS approach for person ages 15 year & above bases on 2nd, 3rd and 4th EUS.
